

F1/Nursery:

To know that keeping my head up when running will help to keep me safe.
To know that standing or moving into a space will keep me safe.
To know that there are rules when playing a game.
To know that scoring helps us know who has won.
To know that there is a winner and a loser in a game.

F2/Reception:

To know that standing in a space means that I cannot touch anyone or anything.
To know that there are rules in a game that everyone must follow to keep it fair.
To know that I can work with a partner or team to score points.
To know that having the highest score means that you are the winner.
To know that some games are individual and in some games you work as a team.

Year 1:

To know that I need to keep my head up to look for defenders.

To know that an attacker is trying to score a point or goal.
To know that a defender is trying to stop the attacker scoring a point or goal.

Year 2:

To know that if I am a defender I am trying to stop passes.
To know that I need to watch the ball in order to intercept it if I am defending.
To know that I need to mark a player and stay with them if I am defending.
To know I need to run into a space away from the defender.
