Listening and Appraising

Year 1:

To know how to listen to short pieces of music across a range of styles and genres with increasing detail to sounds.
To know how to express your own ideas about how music makes you feel using movement as well.
To know if there is any repetition in sounds.
To know how to use expressive language to describe music.
To know that the interrelated dimensions of music can be used to convey a feeling and meaning in a piece of music.

Year 2:

To know how to identify repeated phrases and sounds in longer pieces of music across different styles and genres.
To know that different sounds can be used for different purposes to convey different moods.
To know that using varying changes in the interrelated dimensions of music can create different effects and feelings throughout a single piece of music.
To know that dance can be used to convey feelings to music alongside language and simple movement.
To know there are a variety of features in pieces of music to convey meaning.
