Caring

Year 1:

- To know that people are unique and belong in different ways.
- To know that some people belong to different religions, others not at all.
- To know that different religions may have different beliefs.
- To know that Christian faith teaches Christians values such as honesty, kindness, and generosity.
- To know that different religious teach values that are important to their faith and how we should behave.
- To know that symbols hold meaning in different faiths, e.g. Jesus on the cross.
- To know the role of the places of worship in our communities.
- To know that Christians believe that God looks after them and prayer can help look after others.
- To know that acts of charity are a display of caring and helps different faiths care for people far and wide.
- To know that Church, is a special building where many Christian people worship God and that many other events happen in a church.

Year 2:

- To know that Jews believe God created the world.
- To know the Jewish creation story and that God created the world in seven days (Genesis)
- To know that religious stories hold meaning and different meaning can be inferred.
- To know that Jewish people rest on the 7th day known as Shabbat.
- To know that Shabbat starts each week on a Friday evening and ends on a Saturday evening.
- To know that Abraham is the father of the Jewish people.
