F1/Nursery:

To know I can make marks with a pencil, paintbrush, chalk etc.

To know that a piece of artwork can contain lines and shapes.

To know there are different size brushes e.g. thick and thin.

To know where I need create my piece of art e.g. paper, board, frame

F2/Reception:

To know that using different mediums will create a different effect.

To know that joining up a continuous line will make a closed shape.

To know that a piece of artwork can contain patterns. To know which paintbrush to select to create their art work. E.g. thick, thin.

To know that the size of my art needs to reflect the size of the frame.



Art Knowledge Path

Line, shape, space and pattern

Year 1:

To know that lines can take different forms e.g. wavy, zig zag, straight, diagonal.

To know pencil marks can be lighter / darker depending on the pressure.

To know patterns can be natural e.g veins on leaves, animals, shells etc.

To know that holding a mark making tool closer to the point will increase control and detail.

To know that I can use the space on my page effectively to create a piece of art e.g. considering a skyline.

Year 2:

To know that pencils have different grades (H, HB, and 2B)

To know that an artist may use pattern to make their work more effective.

To know that using different brush stroke techniques lend themselves to different media.

To know that I need to consider the use of size and position to create a piece of art i.e. scale
