To know that materials can be combined.
To know that malleable materials can be changed using hands or tools.
To know that some materials can be shaped into different forms by pressing, pushing, poking, rolling, or stretching.
To know that different materials have different textures e.g. smooth, bumpy, rough etc.
To know that different materials can be used to create a sculpture e.g. mud, paper, playdough, card etc.
To know that paper can be cut, ripped, torn or scrunched to make a collage.

F2/Reception:

To know that that there are different types of joining materials such as PVA glue, masking tape, Sellotape etc.
To know that shapes of malleable materials can be changed and manipulated for a purpose.
To know there are different types of malleable materials such as playdough and clay.
To know that some materials can be shaped into different forms by pinching, folding, squeezing
